

# 1<sup>st</sup> Workshop online on Geoheritage on Volcanic Islands

## Event description

Last June, within the framework of the X ProGeo International Symposium <http://www.igme.es/patrimonio/Xprogeo2020/>, the First Workshop on Geoheritage in Volcanic Islands would have been held. Due to the covid-19 pandemic we had to postpone this X Symposium until next year 2021.

However, we have decided to carry out this First Workshop to present and discuss the final results and conclusions of LIGCANARIAS project with the scientific community, with the aim of sharing experiences and knowledge on geoheritage with other volcanic territories. With this aim, we have organized a webinar of 12 selected presentations that will be free and open broadcast for all those who register, distributed in three thematic sessions: inventories, investigation-geoconservation and geotourism-education.

Each presentation will have a maximum duration of 30 minutes. At the end of each day it will be a round table with all the speakers of that day where the online participants will have a question time open. Last day will be a round table with all the speakers where the online participants will have time for questions and comments with the speakers.
